- While drawing most of the attention from opposing defenses, led Frederick County in scoring with 67 points. His 46 goals were at least eight more than anyone else.
- Named a high school All-American by Adidas and will play on the Mid-Atlantic team in the National Lacrosse Classic, which features the nation's top 500 underclassmen.
- Led Patriots to a winning season.
